

Multiply Blend Mode

Image - Northern Lights

1. Open image > Cmd/alt/shift/N > Cmd/alt/Shift/E
2. Levels > Change Blend Mode to Multiply > Reduce Opacity to say **90%**
3. Now have halo across mountain tops. Cmd/alt/Shift/N > Cmd/alt/Shift/E
4. Choose, Quick Selection tool, (set to 9px, hardness 56%, spacing 18%)
Drag across mountains to reveal marching ants > on the Menu Bar
choose, Select > Modify > Expand > 1 px > OK > Cmd/J > Cmd/
Click on mountain range layer to load selection.
5. Cmd/alt/shift/N > Press S on the keyboard to select the clone stamp tool,
with Opacity and Flow set to **100%** > Clone in mountain range where it
meets the sky, to remove halo > Filter > Gaussian Blur > **1.2 pixels** >
OK > Cmd/D
6. Nik Collection > Define
7. Edit > Stroke > 1 px > centre > use picker tool to choose colour >
OK
